



DR. JOHN SPANGLER

LIFELONG LEARNER



Dr. John Spangler's love of lifelong learning is an inspiration and a reminder that it is never too late to learn something new. A retired pediatric cardiologist, Dr. Spangler embodies the quest for lifelong learning. His journey began in Fremont, NE where at age 14, he delivered papers to save enough money for flying lessons, and eventually earn his pilot's license.

He attended Carleton College in Minnesota for his undergraduate education and the University of Nebraska College of Medicine for his MD degree. Initially unsure of his specialty area, he chose pediatric cardiology, a new and developing field at the time.

Dr. Spangler continued his education by completing a pediatric residency training program followed by a fellowship in pediatric cardiology at Mayo Clinic in Rochester, MN. Because the field was new, he was able to spend time on research and patient care, testing the boundaries of what medicine could accomplish. His journey continued with a move to Danville, PA where he practiced for 20 years holding many positions, including director of pediatric cardiology and chair of the CPR committee.

A new adventure brought Dr. Spangler and his family to South Dakota, where he joined Black Hills Pediatrics and taught pediatrics for the University of South Dakota at the Rapid City campus. He found great fulfillment in helping children and teaching the next generation of pediatricians.

Dr. Spangler estimates he saw around 50,000 patients during his career and is in awe of how far technology has come since his career first began.

A few years after his retirement, Dr. Spangler realized he was not ready to stop learning. Wanting to get back into academia, he found himself connecting with the South Dakota School of Mines & Technology. For the last five years he has been a visiting student in one class each semester. He started by taking classes in geology and has since moved to studying meteorology. Dr. Spangler said he enjoys the stimulation and finds the students extremely engaged and the professors very accessible for help. He has seen how graduates from Mines develop practical skills where they can go out, get a job, and truly make a difference.

Dr. Spangler believes an important way to help students is to provide monetary support and recently decided to fund a fellowship for graduate students studying atmospheric science. Dr. Spangler also encourages others to start thinking about their estate planning. "Put a provision in your will to support students, whether you're a graduate of the school or simply interested in helping students. Include open support in your estate and find a way to help students, because they need it."

Aside from attending classes, Dr. Spangler programs flight simulators for pilots in training. With his vast experience flying planes, he can make the simulators feel more realistic and currently has over 1,200 aircraft simulated on his computer. He is also a member of the Civil Air Patrol, which serves the community by offering emergency services, aerospace education, and cadet programs.

Dr. Spangler is engaged to his fiancé Carol Dugan and enjoys spending time with his children, Benjamin, Rebecca, and Jillian. He is grateful for SD Mines and said it has "made a tremendous difference in my life and the lives of so many others."

Igniting the Passion

The admissions office takes their role in outreach to future generations of scientists and engineers very seriously. Their team is always looking for opportunities to engage elementary, middle school, and high school students in science, technology, engineering, and math (STEM) activities.

One of the ways they open young minds to the challenges and fun of

science and engineering is through summer camps. The university's 12 summer camps are designed to build excitement for future careers in STEM fields. Students travel from all over the country, and even internationally, for personal attention and hands-on experiences doing what SD Mines does best – engineering and science. Campers also explore activities and attractions for which the

spend up to a week on campus using state-of-the-art laboratory equipment and conducting immersive experiments.

To engage even more students, scholarships have become instrumental for increasing enrollment in the camps. **Mike Alley (GeOLE 73)** has been a long-time supporter of summer camp scholarships and has a personal connection to providing financial resources. "We became aware of the need to provide summer camp scholarships through my cousin LuAnn Lindskov, a nationally-recognized math and science teacher at Timber Lake High School. We appreciated LuAnn's

Over the years, the summer camp program has been successful in recruiting future students to SD Mines. According to Taylor Davis, Youth Camp Coordinator/Admissions Counselor, 49 past campers enrolled for fall 2018, which is nearly ten percent of the incoming freshman class, the highest ever.

Mineral industries play an important role in the local, state, and national economy. The engineers and scientists trained in the Mineral Industries building at the South Dakota School of Mines & Technology are key for the future of energy and mining industries, water resource management, environmental protection, paleontology, and the on-going work at the Sanford Underground Research Facility.

SD Mines is one of only five universities in the U.S. offering undergraduate majors in geology and geological engineering, mining

engineering, and metallurgical engineering. Collectively, these are referred to as Mineral Industry (MI) majors.

The current MI building housing these programs was built in the early 1960's and has had no major renovation since its original construction. The building falls short in providing modern spaces that foster collaboration and connectivity among departments and industry.

The university is exploring ways to fund a complete renovation or construction of a new state-of-the-art teaching, research and innovation facility. The plans include cutting-edge research laboratory spaces to serve students, faculty, and industry. The proposed upgrades will help

Mines train scientists and engineers to meet the demands of the 21st century and beyond.

University leaders believe a combination of private donor funds, industry partnerships, and state support can achieve this goal. The plan may also seek help from state officials to appropriate a portion of the precious metals and energy mineral tax to fund a 25-year bond. The tax applies to services and tangible personal property in the precious metal mining industry. Industry leaders recognize that support for the next generation of highly trained scientists and engineers is necessary for continued growth. There is currently strong industry support for using these funds for this purpose.

The South Dakota School of Mines & Technology received a \$3 million donation, the largest gift in school history, from **Larry (ME 72)** and Linda Pearson for an Alumni and Conference Center.

The Pearsons came forward with the desire to help build a facility that would showcase the accomplishments and memories of Mines alumni and the history and traditions of this great university. The Pearson Alumni and Conference Center is funded entirely through private charitable donations from the Pearsons and several other generous alumni and friends.

"We are grateful for the immense generosity of Larry and Linda Pearson," said Joel Kincart, SDSM&T Foundation President. "This gift will make a

difference for generations to come. It provides a home base for vital collaboration between alumni and students and provides a space where supporters of SD Mines can take part in the positive impact this university has on the community, state, nation, and world."

The center is being built on private property west of the Surbeck Center and features a variety of spaces for holding community events, alumni visits, and university needs. The Alumni Association and Foundation will be housed together to support university events and alumni visits. Spaces readily accessible to campus will include a ballroom that can host up to 100 guests, meeting rooms of various sizes and configurations, and a board room.



After his brother-in-law Dr. Gordon Stanley Owen passed away, **John Garrison (CE 51)** and his wife Jan wanted to find a way to recognize him for the support he offered Garrison during his time at SD Mines. To honor his memory and help the campus community, they established the Dr. Gordon Stanley Owen, M.D. Memorial Scholarship for students studying in the health care field.

Stanley, as Garrison fondly remembers him, was a long time Rapid City resident and physician who served the Rapid City high school football and basketball teams. He was an active Shriner and donned the clown costume on many occasions.

While his impact on the community was immense, Garrison remembers Stanley for the personal assistance he provided. Originally from Kansas, Garrison lived with his sister Claire and brother-in-law Stanley, trading babysitting for room and board. As an out-of-state student, the only way he afforded his education was with Stanley's support and working at Knecht Lumber to cover his tuition.

Upon graduation, Garrison worked for Boeing in Wichita KS, served in the Air Force during the Korean War, was a roadway engineer for Rand Construction in the Badlands, and was a professional engineer for HNTB in Kansas City, MO and PBSJ in Florida

met and married here. Nikolaev and his siblings primarily grew up in Rapid City, SD and he attended South Dakota State University for two years before transferring to Mines. "I chose to attend the School of Mines because I felt they were capable of challenging me and pushing me to be better."

Jacob Oberpriller, a senior from Hot Springs, SD, was the most recent recipient of the scholarship and will be graduating in spring of 2019 with a degree in Industrial Engineering and Engineering Management. He remarks, "I want to thank Mr. and Mrs. Garrison for the generosity they have shown me and for helping future students. I am truly honored to be the recipient of this award."

Nikolaev and Jacob, like many students, have benefited greatly from receiving scholarships and are very appreciative of Garrison's support.



THE CLASS GIFT: AN ENDURING LEGACY

DEAR Friends

I want to sincerely thank everyone who has contributed to the Foundation. Your generosity is vital in providing support to the university. You have made this past year a tremendous success; in fact, it was the best year ever for scholarship dollars and third best year for total dollars raised.

While all gifts benefit SD Mines and donors are encouraged to support areas of their interest and passion, perhaps the greatest area of need is scholarships. SD Mines is unable to offer scholarships from public funds; therefore, all scholarships are funded by private donors. Scholarships have the power to open the door to a college education for talented students who might otherwise be unable to attend. These awards are frequently the determining factor when high-achieving students are deciding whether or not they can attend college.

As Investment Committee Chair, I have the opportunity to work with dedicated committee members who are committed to making a difference in the lives of our students and positively impact SD Mines. These individuals provide many hours of service to carry out the mission and goals of the Foundation and their time and energy is greatly appreciated.

The committee seeks to balance reasonable returns against excessive risk and continues to work with our investment advisor, INNOVEST. The move started two years ago to replace hedge funds and actively managed funds with index funds. The transition is complete and currently all equity and fixed income fund assets are invested in index funds.

Over the past five years, investment returns have averaged 6.4% per year, with our investment return this fiscal year coming in at 7.1%. Our endowment has grown to \$61 million in principal and spending accounts.

SD Mines is very fortunate to have the continued support and generosity of our loyal alumni and friends. The following pages highlight the Foundation's financial standing and giving area priorities. While we are grateful for a fantastic year, there are still areas of great need and opportunity to provide the best education and training for tomorrow's leaders.








